

E-SCOOTER LICENCE RULES

Did you know that ... an e-scooter restricted to 30mph is treated as a 50cc petrol scooter.

Which means, an e-scooter such as a Segway B110S, E110S or E125S can be ridden by anyone aged at least 16 with a Provisional moped licence and a CBT (Compulsory Basic Training) certificate. Riders have to display L-plates and cannot carry a pillion. To ride without L-plates, they must take a further advanced motorcycle practical and theory test.

However, if your Full car licence was obtained before 1st December 2001, you can ride a 30mph electric scooter without L-plates or a CBT certificate. If it was obtained after this date, you need a CBT certificate.
